Knighton Award For Audit Excellence & Website Award Mark 3rd Consecutive Award-Winning Year

City Auditor Laura Doud announced today that her Office has won the prestigious Knighton Gold Award for its 2009 Towing Operations Audit. This award for excellence is the highest honor given by the Association of Local Government Auditors (ALGA), which represents over 300 local audit organizations nationwide.

"We are very honored to receive this Gold Award. This is certainly a highlight for our hardworking auditors and staff. We would like to thank ALGA for recognizing the quality of our work on behalf of Long Beach taxpayers," said City Auditor Doud.

Notable to the judges was the audit's potential for significant impact and the innovative manner in which the audit was conducted. City Auditor Doud said, "One of the most important things to me about our audits is that the recommendations we make are implemented to improve City operations. I would like to acknowledge the Towing Bureau for taking our recommendations to heart and working to strengthen their systems to protect our City assets."

The Knighton Award is one of two prizes for 2009 achievement announced by ALGA this week for Long Beach. The City Auditor's website, www.CityAuditorLauraDoud.com, earned a Silver Award for its informative content and ease of navigation.
